### SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

- **ELIGIBLE STUDENTS:** Open to students who are self-identified LGBTQ+, members of LGBTQ+ families, or straight allies. High school senior, undergraduate, graduate or post-graduate student, age 17 and older.
- **RESIDENCY:** Southeastern Wisconsin (Kenosha, Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Racine, Sheboygan, Walworth, Washington, Waukesha Counties), with a desire to reside in Southeastern Wisconsin after graduation.
- **ENROLLMENT:** Any accredited post-secondary education degree or GED program in Southeastern Wisconsin. Full-time enrollment is required for undergraduate students. Part-time minimum enrollment (6 credits), with 6 credits earned, is required for professional, graduate and postgraduate students.
- **LEADERSHIP & COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT:** Demonstrated support of LGBTQ+ communities and have demonstrated a commitment to equality, human rights and social justice.
- **ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENT:** Online application.
